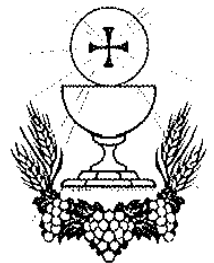

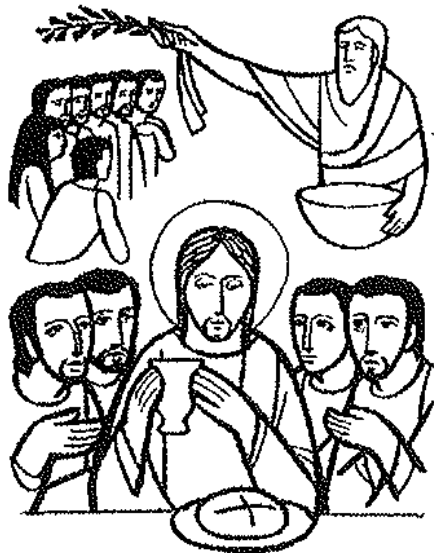
## ABM Reflection

The Eucharist, the Holy Communion, the Blessed Sacrament of Bread and Wine are often the most precious parts of our spiritual life. This is one of the two commandments Jesus told us to do, 'Do this in remembrance of me'. Yet it is looked at in so many different ways by different groups.

Transubstantiation (the changing of the bread and wine into the actual Body and Blood of Christ), or a changing spiritually to the Body and Blood of Christ, or to some just another activity (almost like a picnic!!) This, to me, is the greatest block to true ecumenism. We are happy to pray with other Christians, read Scripture with them, sing hymns and songs with them, hear others preach the Word but how we see this most important ritual is stopping us from being truly one in our worship.

- Give thanks for the fact that we can celebrate the Holy Communion, the reception of the Body and Blood of Jesus, each in our own ways and within our own spiritualities.
- Give thanks for the Anglican Church of Korea, the *Daehan Seong Gong Hoe*.
