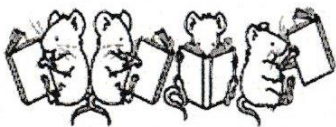
Announcements and Upcoming Events

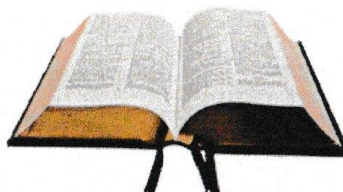
