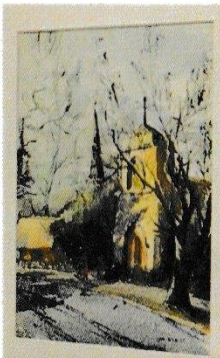

## ANNOUNCEMENTS & UPCOMING EVENTS

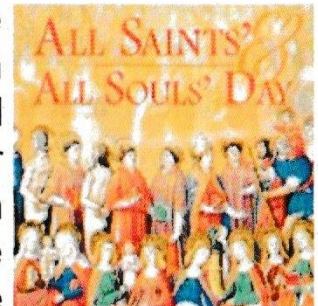
